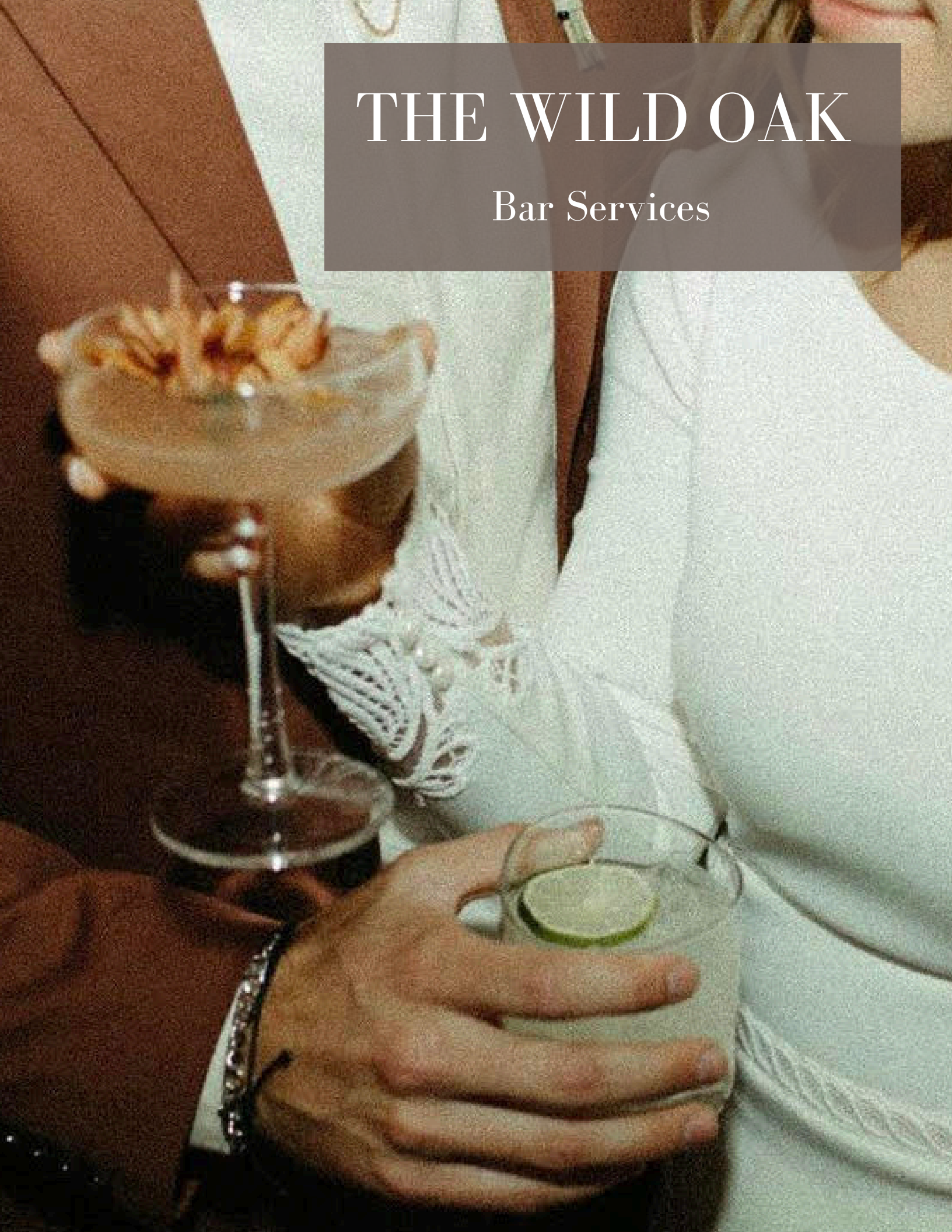

Bar Services

Cash Bar

*A cash bar is a bar service where guests are required to pay for their own drinks.
Here's a description of what you can expect at a cash bar:*

- **Bar Setup:** The cash bar will be inside on our glass bar complete with bartenders, a variety of alcohol options, and necessary bar equipment.
- **Payment Process:** Guests are responsible for paying for their drinks individually. This means they must use cash, venmo or credit/debit cards to settle their bar tabs. The bride and groom will pay the venue service fee and nonalcoholic drink flat fee.
- **Drink Selection:** Variety of spirits, wines, beers, seltzers and non alcoholic drinks
- **Pricing for client :** You will be in charge of a flat fee of \$500 for liquor license venue fee + \$3/per head to supply bottomless non alcoholic drinks.
- **Pricing for guests :** Prices for drinks at a cash bar are similar to what one might find at a regular bar or restaurant. We will have a price list and a menu displayed so that guests can see the cost of each drink (see menu). Non-alcoholic drinks will be complimentary to all guests.
- **Bartenders:** Experienced bartenders are on hand to mix cocktails, serve drinks, and ensure responsible alcohol service.
- **Accounting:** Guests are usually required to settle their bar tabs as they go, meaning they pay for each drink individually.
- **Customization:** Couples may have the option to customize the cash bar to fit their theme or preferences. This could include signature cocktails, personalized drink napkins, stirring sticks or cups the client provides, or thematic decorations that The Wild Oak will provide.
- **Communication:** It's essential to communicate to guests that there will be a cash bar at the wedding. This information is typically included in the wedding invitation or on the wedding website so that guests can come prepared with cash, cards, venmo.
- **Servingware :** drinks will be served in nice hardy plastic cups with different shapes.

Open Bar

An open bar at a wedding venue is a generous and hospitable beverage service option that offers a wide range of alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks to your wedding guests without additional charges. Here's a description of what you can expect at an open bar:

Exact Price Estimate + Charge

You will be charged and exact \$35 per person drinking. To ensure you are not overcharged or undercharged you will pay 2 payments before the wedding then the 3rd payment will happen after the wedding so we can charge for the exact guest count.

Exact Price Estimate + Charge

You will be charged and exact \$30 per person drinking. To ensure you are not overcharged or undercharged you will pay 2 payments before the wedding then the 3rd payment will happen after the wedding so we can charge for the exact guest count.

Ticketed Bar/Pricing

A ticketed bar is a way to offer drinks to guests while maintaining budget control. Couples will have the flexibility to determine the number of drinks per ticket each guest receives and allow guests to purchase more drinks if desired after the complimentary ones the couple purchases. This approach can contribute to a smooth and enjoyable wedding reception for all attendees.

1. **Pre-purchase:** Couples may have the option to pre-purchase a certain number of drink tickets for each guest.
2. **Ticket Distribution:** Guests receive their drink tickets upon arrival at the wedding when they first go to the bar.
3. **Redemption:** When a guest wants a drink, they present their ticket to the bartender. The bartender then provides the specified drink.
4. **Monitoring:** The bartenders will mark the tickets to keep track of how many drinks each guest has consumed.
5. **Additional Tickets:** If guests want more drinks, they can purchase additional drinks at the venue.
6. **Closing the Bar:** The ticketed bar will close at a designated time that the couple decides.
7. **Pricing :** Pricing will be determined on what kind of bar the client wants, what drinks are available for the guests, how many drinks they would like to purchase. Schedule a bartending meeting via our website to get more information about which package is best for you.
